What do you have for breakfast?

John, Owen and Lily talk about what they have for breakfast.

John: Cereal, toast, crumpets, the usual stuff.

Owen: Usually cereal and some apricots, and some drink and a banana. I don't have toast everyday, I have cereal everyday. I have this everyday, but I don't have toast.

Lily: I usually have a couple of slices of toast, maybe a fruit salad and, yeah, pancakes.

Do you have school dinners?

John, Owen and Lily talk about school dinners.

Do you have school dinner or do you have a packed lunch?

John: Sometimes I have packed lunch, sometimes I have school dinners.

Owen: Sometimes I have school dinners. I have school dinner two times, which is school preparing a lunch for me, and packed lunch three times in a week, and that is me taking my own food three days.

Lily: For lunch I sometimes have a school dinner and sometimes I have a packed lunch, which usually consists of a sandwich and maybe a chocolate bar and, yeah ... that's a packed lunch. For school dinners we have things like sausages and mash, and fruit for afters.

Which do you prefer?

John: I probably prefer school dinners because they give you a menu for that so you actually know what's coming.

Owen: No I don't like school dinners, but I like packed lunch. ... Because sometimes they have things I don't like.

Lily: I probably prefer a packed lunch, because the school dinners don't really appeal to me that much.

What is your favourite food?

John, Owen and Lily talk about their favourite food.

John: Pizza, pizza, pizza!

Owen: My favourite food is strawberries and blueberries.

Lily: I quite like pasta, spaghetti, penne, yeah...

What is your least favourite food?

John, Owen and Lily talk about their least favourite food.

John: Any vegetables apart from carrots and potatoes

Owen: Baked beans and potatoes, I'm not very keen on potatoes.

Lily: I don't really like pizza.

Do you like cooking?

John, Owen and Lily talk about cooking.

John: I cook anything apart from cake, if I'm asked to.
(in the kitchen) Some butter ... er ... some brown sugar, chocolate.

Owen: Not exactly, because I've never actually tried to cook.

Lily: Yes I quite like cooking but I don't have much time for it. I quite like to cook things like cake, muffins and biscuits.

(in the kitchen) Today I'm going to be making some fudgy banana muffins Ah...vanilla essence here.
